

1:00 PM: MANNY CHACON - HIP HOP & CULTURE



MANNY CHACON IS A PROFESSIONAL DANCER, CHOREOGRAPHER, AND EDUCATOR WHOSE ARTISTRY BLENDS HIP HOP, AFRO-DIASPORIC MOVEMENT, AND THE BRAZILIAN ART OF CAPOEIRA. WITH YEARS OF PERFORMANCE AND TEACHING EXPERIENCE ACROSS SCHOOLS, UNIVERSITIES, AND STAGES NATIONWIDE, MANNY USES DANCE AS BOTH A CULTURAL BRIDGE AND A TOOL FOR COMMUNITY BUILDING. HIS WORKSHOP WILL OFFER PARTICIPANTS AN ENGAGING, HIGH-ENERGY EXPLORATION OF RHYTHM, MOVEMENT, AND EXPRESSION DESIGNED TO BE ACCESSIBLE TO ALL LEVELS WHILE INSPIRING CONFIDENCE AND CREATIVITY.

BORN AND RAISED IN WILMINGTON, CHRIS DEVANY HAS OVER 20 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE STUDYING THE BRAZILIAN ART OF CAPOEIRA. HE TRAINED UNDER MASTER ADENILSON DOS SANTOS AND LATER EARNED THE DISTINGUISHED TITLE OF MESTRE, BECOMING THE FIRST DELAWARE NATIVE TO DO SO. CHRIS CONTINUES TO TEACH AND PERFORM CAPOEIRA, PERCUSSION, AND MOVEMENT NATIONALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY, SHARING THE RICH CULTURE AND TRADITIONS OF BRAZIL.

3:00 PM: DARA J. MEREDITH - CHOREO THROUGH GESTURES



STREET DANCE THEATER, HE BRINGS HIP HOP, HOUSE, AND OTHER STREET STYLES TO THE STAGE WITH ARTISTRY AND AUTHENTICITY.
